Handlers will learn to identify the problems that keep them from being successful. As handlers progress so will the challenges leading to running both an opening and doing the gamble in the closing.

Topics will include:

- What cues turn your dog toward you and away from you?
- The ability to redirect your dog.
- Independent obstacle performance, adding distance to that performance.
- Does your dog understand your body language and the cues you use?
- Are you consistent with the information you send?
- Timing of your information to your dog.
- Creating an opening plan that flows into the closing.
- Are you where you want to be when the whistle blows?
- The mental game
- Does your dog respond to your obedience commands instantly?
- Building in a safety plan, and the ability to recover

Please come with an open mind and ready to try new things.

You will need a clicker, toys and high value treats, lots of them and a hungry dog.
